



## Lessons Learned Oral History Project

### Ron Borzekowski

---

The Yale Program on Financial Stability (YPFS) interviewed Ron Borzekowski regarding his time as Deputy Research Director for the Financial Crisis Inquiry Commission established in the aftermath of the financial crisis of 2007-09. Borzekowski was a senior economist at the Federal Reserve Board when he was detailed to join the FCIC as a senior researcher. Borzekowski's research examined consumer financial services; developments in the payments industry, the adoption and impact of new technologies; and the strategic interactions among financial institutions.

After the FCIC completed its work, Borzekowski returned to the Fed briefly before joining the new Consumer Financial Protection Board (CFPB) established in 2011. Beginning in 2013, he served as Assistant Director of Research for the CFPB.

At the time of this interview, he was Director, Economics at Amazon Web Services.
