Stefan Ingves

The Yale Program on Financial Stability interviewed Stefan Ingves in December 2022. From January 2006 through December 2022, he was head of Sweden's central bank, the Sveriges Riksbank. In November 2021, he was elected to a three-year term as vice-chairman of the Bank of International Settlements. He was previously chairman of the Basel Committee, director of the Monetary and Financial Systems Department at the International Monetary Fund, deputy governor of the Riksbank, and general director of the Swedish Bank Support Authority. During Sweden's banking crisis of the early 1990s, he was undersecretary and head of the Financial Markets Department at the Ministry of Finance.
