
Student Life

You'll round out your curriculum by choosing from more than 170 elective courses at Yale SOM and over 1,000 courses throughout Yale University. Through these courses, you can get an in-depth look at a specific industry or expand your knowledge in a topic like public health, sustainability, psychology, or the arts.

Management Science Major

Students can qualify for a management science major by completing a minimum number of credits in eligible courses focusing on application of statistical modeling, data warehousing/mining, programming, forecasting, and research techniques. Students who complete this major have the opportunity to qualify for an additional two-year STEM extension of their one-year Post-Completion OPT (Optional Practical Training) work permission. The Management Science Major is designed for students who are dedicated to a career in STEM and planning to work in the United States after graduation.

Application information & deadlines

Admission to the Yale GBS program is open to early career (approximately three years or less of experience) individuals who are current or former students of Master in Management (or equivalent) degrees. **Round 1** is exclusively reserved for Global Network for Advanced Management students. **Round 2 and 3** are open to students from non-Global Network schools as well as Global Network Schools.

M2M

The M2M alliance is a collaboration among four Global Network schools which allows future leaders to earn two master's degrees in two years in two countries, by applying simultaneously to two programs. The Yale GBS program is offered as the second year of the M2M following a year of study at **HEC Paris**, Hong Kong's **HKUST Business School**, or the **University of British Columbia's Sauder School of Business**.
