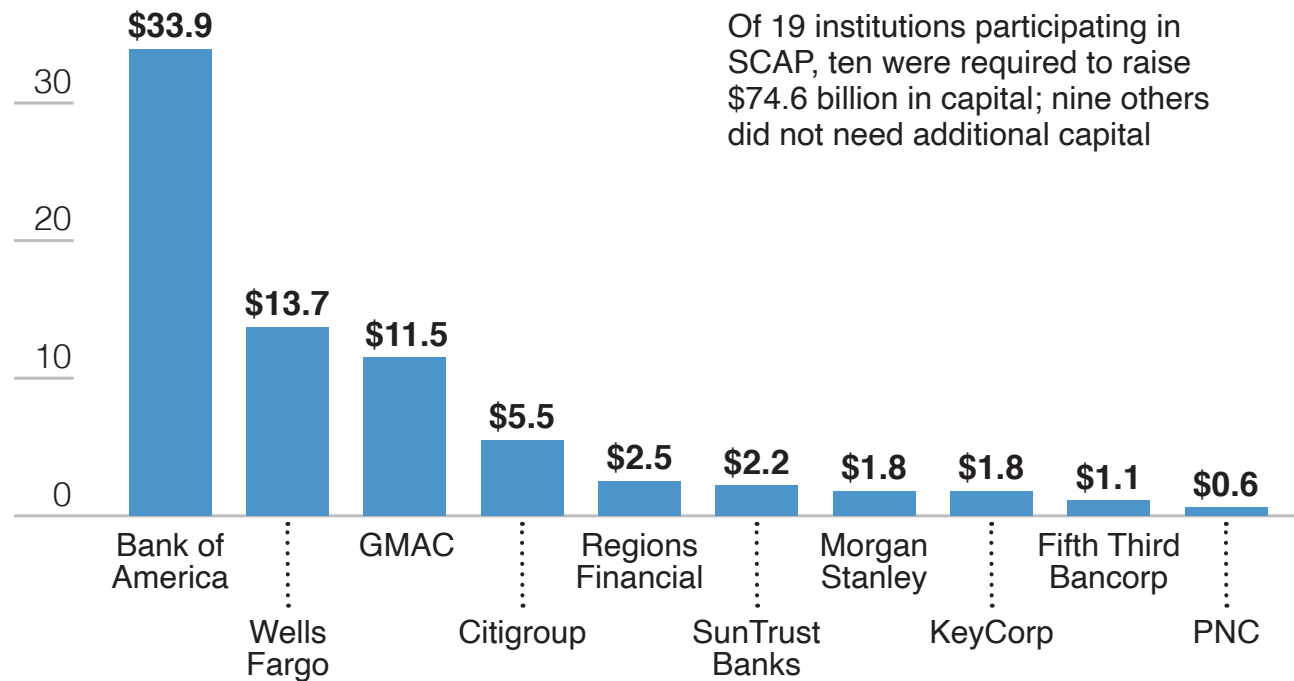


Stress Test Results: Capital Raises Needed, May 7, 2009

Citigroup's requirement, for example, fell from \$92.6 billion to \$5.5 billion after adjusting for capital actions and earnings in the first quarter of 2009 and its plan to convert approximately \$58 billion of preferred stock into common equity.
